

St. Timothy's Adult Mission Trip

Information about the adult mission trip to Costa Rica is being finalized and there are now details that can be passed along to you.

PROJECT: Our mission group will be working at the Church of the Ascension in San Jose. The project will consist of painting a large room in a building adjacent to the church and relocating the furnishings that are currently in the worship area to the new space. This will be temporary housing while the worship space is being enlarged. Also there is a room in this same building that we will insulate, panel, and make ready to house the sewing machine project for HIV+ women to be able to earn a living.

WHEN: The trip is scheduled for November 14th - November 21st 2010.

HOUSING: Our group will stay at the Diocesan House in San Jose. It is a clean, comfortable, and safe facility with an on-site chapel.

MEALS: Most meals will be at the Diocesan House. Lunch on work days will probably be on site and there may be some dinners at local restaurants.

TRANSPORTATION TO COSTA RICA: We will fly out of Charlotte non-stop to San Jose leaving at 11:23 a.m. Sunday and arriving at 2:30 p.m. We will depart San Jose Sunday (21st) at 3:35 p.m. and arrive back in Charlotte at 8:44 p.m. The current cost of airfare is \$464. We are requesting that each person taking the trip be responsible for the cost of their own airfare.

TRANSPORTATION WHILE IN SAN JOSE: Depending on the size of our group, we will be transported each day via our own van or bus with a driver that is known by the diocesan house staff.

FUNDRAISING: Various fund raising activities are planned for July through September. Plans are underway for a golf tournament scheduled for August 21. The goal is to raise enough money to cover the costs of each group member (except for airfare) and the construction supplies that will be required for the project.

SIZE OF GROUP: Ideally, a group of approximately 16 would be suitable. If we get less than that, we will adjust work to the number of people that we have. The maximum number of people that the Diocesan House can accommodate is 30.

PASSPORTS: Passports are required so please make sure yours is up to date. If you do not have a passport, you should begin this process asap in order to have enough time for your application to be processed.
